### Minutes from the September 3, 2008 Meeting

### Treasurer's Report:

The treasurer report was read and circulated. Ending Balances (after this years taxes of \$2383.60 were paid) for August are \$3578.49 in the checking and \$8659.72 in the savings. A motion to approve was made by Rich Goshorn and seconded by Walt Srebalus.

### Committee Reports:

#### Building:

The ceiling is ¼ done. The TV stand has been built. After Terry picked up the paint, the outside of the clubhouse received one coat of paint. It still needs a second coat. The front door needs to be painted as well. A white or off white should be fine. Also, firewood needs to be cut and stacked.

The fuel oil price is currently at \$3.549, 2cents less if 300 or more are purchased. It has been decided to continue to wait for the price to drop. Fay will check into the newer bio-diesel fuel prices to see how they compare.

#### Grounds:

Kelly got a quote from Rich Campbell, on the parking lot for \$3700.00. This includes lowering the high spots, filling in the low spots, taking the grass out of the center and laying down 1-2" of new stone. An area about 90' x 180'. A motion was made by Joe Kutz and seconded by Rich Goshorn, to take a vote to approve spending up to \$4000.00 on the new parking lot. A vote was taken and passed.

Kelly and Justin spent some time pouring concrete and sealing cracks in the driveway around the pipe.

The oil needs to be changed in the riding mower before it's used on Saturday.

The tree stand needs to be built over at the new outdoor range.

**Indoor:**

1000 sheets of cardboard will be arriving to repair the shooting wall. It has been suggested to use sand bags or other weight to help hold down the shrink-wrap.

**3-D:**

The outdoor 3-D league for next year will be changing. The cost to enter a club is \$200.00. There will be 4 clubs involved. Reading will host the first Sunday of each month, from April thru August. It will be promoted and advertised. There will be new score cards and two divisions, moveable site and pin site. Trophies will now be a shirt or jacket that can be proudly worn and not a plaque or trophy to get put away.

**Activities:**

We are signed up for next years Expo running from January 15 to the 18<sup>th</sup> of 2009. We will again be located in the back. The same location as last year. We should be able to get in at night to set up. The Promoter is trying to get Ted Nugget to come back and shoot.

We need to decide what month to make the gun raffle.
